Bible Point – God’s Word is life-changing.

Bible Story – Peter and John teach about Jesus. (Acts 3:1 – 4:12)

Bible Verse – “Give me life through your word.” (Psalm 119:37)

Our Bible story today again came from the book of Acts. God had given Peter and John special power. In Jesus’ name, they healed a crippled beggar. Then Peter told the onlookers about Jesus and his life-changing love for all of them (and us!).

In *Bible Voyage*, they met the beggar in Jerusalem who had experienced God’s life-changing healing power. *Ship Rec Games* had the kids playing Walk the Plank. In *Chipper Ship Crafts*, they made Magic Color Scratch Ships. *Goodies From the Galley* had a sweet reminder of God’s forgiveness and in *Sail Away Cinema*, they watched to see if the crew could steer without a ship’s wheel.



The Sensational Sailors talked about how it is important to allow God’s Word to change our lives and not to get stuck. They worked some more on their skits for Friday and continued on their week of mission projects by making blankets.
